

DIGITAL ID NON-PARTICIPATION – GUIDANCE SHEET (A4)

HOW TO USE YOUR NOTICE

1. Print and sign your Digital ID Non-Participation Notice.
 2. Provide it whenever asked to use Digital ID, facial recognition, biometric login, or app-based ID.
 3. Keep a copy for your records.
 4. You may deliver it:
 - In person
 - By email (scan or photo)
 - By registered post (best for institutions)
 5. Ask for written acknowledgment within 14 days.
 6. Always offer your physical ID as an alternative:
 - Driver's Licence
 - Medicare Card
 - Passport (if needed)

WHO TO GIVE IT TO

Use it only when Digital ID or biometrics are being pushed:

- Employers using biometric sign-in systems
 - Housing, real estate or utilities requiring app-based ID
 - Banks requiring Digital ID instead of physical ID
 - Government departments removing manual ID pathways
 - Schools introducing facial recognition
 - Medical centres using biometric check-in

YOUR RIGHTS

- Digital ID in Australia is voluntary.
 - Organisations **MUST** offer a manual alternative.
 - Under the Privacy Act 1988 and APPs, you may refuse biometric collection.
 - Refusal of service due to non-participation may breach Australian Consumer Law.

KEEP RECORDS

- Log who you gave the notice to
 - Date of delivery
 - Any responses you receive
